Breakfast Connections

The Cornwall Business Enterprise Centre recently hosted its Breakfast Connections series in South Glengarry, featuring local business owner Chris Bourgon as the keynote speaker. About 60 attendees enjoyed breakfast while hearing from local officials, including Mayor Lachlan McDonald, who emphasized the importance of supporting small businesses. Bourgon, owner of Gilles' 3rd Gen Barbershop, shared his journey, highlighting challenges and accomplishments. He emphasized adopting a growth mindset, discussed overcoming obstacles during the pandemic, and commended fellow business owners.



Half Load Season: Now in effect throughout the region

The unexpected mild weather this winter has prompted the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas, and Glengarry (SDG Counties) to initiate its half-load season on local roads earlier than usual. Commencing on February 21, a notable three weeks ahead of the standard schedule, this precautionary measure is crucial for preserving the integrity of roads during the vulnerable winter-spring transition. SDG Counties, in collaboration with local municipalities and the City of Cornwall, is enforcing a five-tonne per axle weight limit on designated weaker roads across the region. These roads, identified by specific signs, are subject to seasonal weight restrictions to mitigate potential damage. The half-load season is anticipated to persist until the early part of May, although the conclusion may be subject to adjustments based on prevailing weather conditions throughout the spring. This proactive approach underscores the importance of adapting to changing climatic patterns to ensure the longevity and safety of local road infrastructure.
