Service Delivery and Process Review

Council awarded RFP 17-2022 for a Service Delivery and Processes Review to KPMG LLP. The objective of the project is to complete a comprehensive assessment of the Township's current administrative practices and to identify opportunities for improving efficiencies. The Township has been approved funding of up to \$152,640 towards the completion of this project through the Municipal Modernization Program – Intake. KPMG's submission of \$109,943 plus HST is within the approved funding, which will result in no impact on the 2022 budget.

Boys and Girls Club - Presentation

Deborah Locke of the BGC provided Council with an overview of the childcare/camp services available in South Glengarry for children aged 6-12. Registration is almost full for the 2022 Summer Camp being held at Paul Rozon Park from July 4th to August 26th, 2022. BGC has received positive feedback from the community and are exploring the possibility of providing services for younger children aged 4-6 in 2023. The Township is excited about the partnership!



Revised Procedural By-law

Administration presented Council with a revised procedural by-law. A procedural by-law governs the calling, place and proceedings of meetings. The draft by-law proposes several significant amendments and additions to the previous by-law including provisions for the livestreaming and recording of meetings, electronic participation in meetings and the Order of Business for regular meetings. It is anticipated that the by-law will be passed at the June 6th Regular Council meeting.
